Based in Tromsø in northern Norway, FarOut have created a series of three-night / four-day 'adventure' packages for both winter and summer - ideal for those seeking a new challenge, and more than suitable for families.

Tromsø, which is just a three-hour flight from London, lies inside the Arctic Circle and is considered one of Norway's most attractive and fashionable cities. It lies in a spectacular setting, surrounded by majestic peaks and icy Arctic waters. It is here, in the beautiful land of the Aurora Borealis and the Midnight Sun, that FarOut challenge their guests.

The winter 'adventure' includes a cable car ride up the Floya Mountain and a day of dog sledding, along with a day for you to choose from a selection of optional activities. These include ice fishing, a skidoo safari, reindeer sledding, Arctic deep-sea fishing and 'ski bagging' - touring from peak to peak by powder skiing and boat. An action packed day ends with a traditional Arctic dinner.

In the summer months, dog sledding is replaced by a day's whale watching, and optional activities include fjord kayaking, tandem paragliding, mountain treks and Arctic deep-sea fishing.

This would be ideal for a party of family or friends (minimum 8 pax), with a weekend of excitement that can be tailored specifically for you. Alternatively you could join one of FarOut's scheduled weekends - there is still space next summer on 23rd - 26th May and 18th - 21st July 2009.

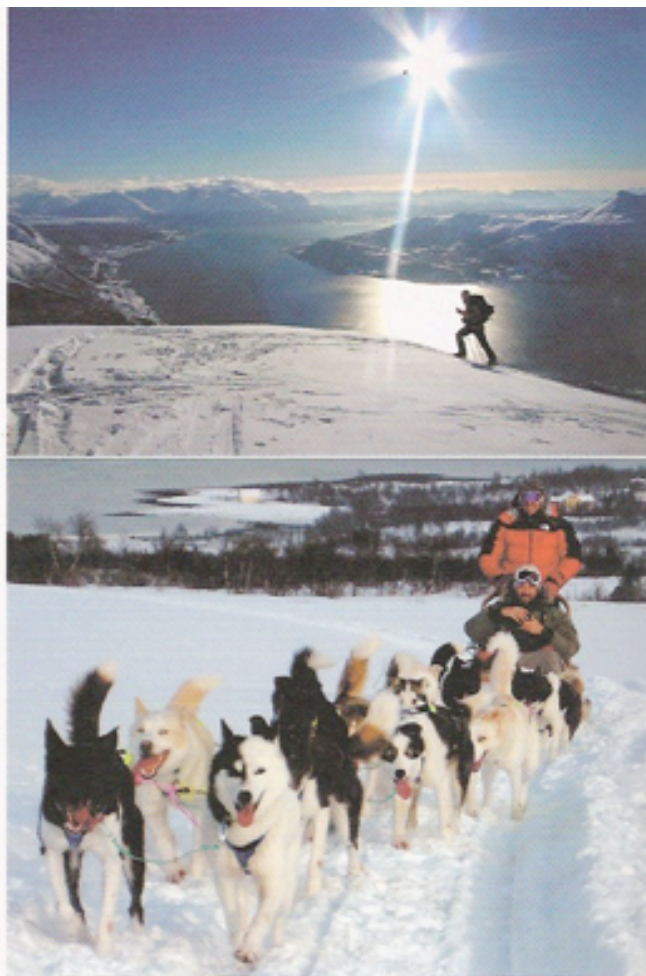
